



NAVLE® NON-STANDARD TESTING CONDITIONS REQUEST PACKET

OVERVIEW

The International Council for Veterinary Assessment® (ICVA®) administers the North American Veterinary Licensing Examination (NAVLE), which is a requirement for licensure to practice veterinary medicine in all United States and Canada licensing jurisdictions. The ICVA administers the NAVLE in three (3) testing windows annually in:

OCTOBER – NOVEMBER

MARCH

JULY – AUGUST

The ICVA reviews and processes additional break time/non-standard testing requests for NAVLE candidates with temporary medical conditions (i.e., post-surgery, injury, lactation). You may apply for non-standard testing conditions by submitting the [NAVLE Non-Standard Testing Conditions Request Form](#), with a letter from a qualified professional documenting the need for the request. The request should be submitted prior to or at the same time you apply for the NAVLE.

⚠️ Note: If you already have a scheduling permit for a standard examination, [contact the ICVA](#) immediately.

DEADLINES

⚠️ Your completed and supported NAVLE Non-Standard Testing Conditions Request Form must be received no later than 14 days before the start of the testing window.

This deadline is fixed and does not change even if testing windows are expanded or extended. Requests are processed in the order in which they are received. It is recommended that you submit your completed and supported NAVLE Non-Standard Testing Conditions Request Form as far in advance of the applicable deadline date as possible in case additional information is needed.

BEST PRACTICES

Whenever possible, the ICVA will acknowledge receipt of your request and contact you in writing via e-mail if additional information or documentation needed to decide and act on your request. Please send copies (do not send originals) of all official documentation that you submit the ICVA is unable to return submissions or provide duplicate copies to third parties.

- do not receive an e-mail acknowledgement after request submission.

TIME FORMAT

All exams administered with additional break time **must** be taken over two days. The only formats available for the NAVLE in these cases are:

Standard Format

Day 1: 10-minute tutorial, 12 blocks of 30 items in 33 minutes, and at least 50 minutes of break time, for a total of 7 hours and 36 minutes.

Additional Break Time/Non-Standard Testing

Day 1: 10-minute tutorial, 16 blocks of 12 items in 13 minutes and 12 seconds, and at least 85 minutes of break time, for a total of 5 hours, 6 minutes, and 12 seconds.

Day 2: 3-minute tutorial, 14 blocks of 12 items in 13 minutes and 12 seconds, and at least 70 minutes of break time, for a total of 4 hours, 17 minutes, and 48 seconds.



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REQUEST GUIDELINES

Complete all sections of the [NAVLE Non-Standard Testing Conditions Request Form](#) and submit it together with all required supporting documentation. Supporting documents should meet the document requirements below.

Required Documentation:

Please obtain and submit documentation from a qualified professional that clearly establishes the necessity of the request for additional break time/non-standard testing. To reduce the likelihood of processing delays, the documentation from the credentialing professional must be:

1	written in English (you are responsible for providing certified English translations of all non-English documentation),
2	legible (i.e., typewritten),
3	signed and dated by the professional,
4	written on the professional's letterhead (handwritten and/or prescription pad documentation are not acceptable), and
5	include a listing of the professional's qualifications (i.e., degree, licensure, and areas of specialization).

SUBMITTING YOUR COMPLETED REQUEST FORM AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

Ensure delivery of your completed NAVLE Non-Standard Testing Conditions Request Form and documentation by the deadlines below via one of the methods below:

⚠️ Note: Any Non-Standard Testing Conditions request must be received no later than 14 days before the start of the testing window.

If submitting by e-mail or upload, you must submit this request form and all supporting documentation in PDF format with scanned or electronic signatures. Signature pages may be submitted as a digital photograph file (.jpg or .jpeg).

Microsoft Word files cannot be authenticated and are not accepted. Google Drive, Dropbox, or other embedded cloud storage links are not accepted.

APPROVAL

Non-standard testing conditions will be valid for one (1) year from the approval date.
